

A professional career portfolio is a 21st Century web-based networking instrument that conveys your unique value proposition to decision makers.


Your portfolio can encompass your presentations, publications, charts, graphs and work samples, ensuring that you are presented in the best possible light. It enhances your reputation and your prestige, positioning your focused message in the minds of decision makers, and increases your authority and credibility. No other career tool can provide the benefits of a professional web portfolio.

Competitive Edge

Career web portfolios leverage the multi-media power of the internet to deliver information-rich content which enables candidates and hiring managers to rapidly understand each other. Developed and used properly, a career web portfolio provides you with a competitive edge and differentiates you from other candidates. It is also an indispensable tool for business and career networking in today's interconnected world.

Business and Professional Networking

Today's candidates are networking in a high-tech, web-enabled world. A professional portfolio portrays you as up-to-date, web-savvy and a self-promoter. It introduces you and your achievements in a unique, elegant way, helping you to promote yourself in your company, your industry, your community and your profession.

You have a lot at stake in your career. Your web portfolio should deliver the greatest possible value to you in advancing your business and financial interests. To achieve this, your portfolio needs to educe the maximum possible mileage from the internet medium in conveying a powerful message to the organizations you want to work for.



Building extremely effective career portfolios requires professional training and skills which are not intuitively obvious even to highly educated people. Unless you have considerable expertise in these areas, your suggestions may not be improvements.

Your portfolio will *not* be registered with search engines. The portfolio does not magically generate leads, nor is it a substitute for good old-fashioned preparation. Rather, it augments the resume, job search and interviewing process.

Your online portfolio is a permanent career asset which can serve you in advancing your career interests through business networking for many years. Your career portfolio is hosted on a powerful, dedicated web hosting server with data security and privacy protection. Graphs and Charts

The portfolio's ability to display quantified achievements in visually-impactful graphs and charts helps to create a compelling business case for the client's candidacy. Quantifying achievements becomes more important than ever for portfolio clients.

A well done career portfolio quantifies, wherever possible, how much total value in dollars the candidate has created directly or as part of a leadership team, such as:

- Revenue enhancement
- Cost savings
- Customer satisfaction
- Employee productivity
- Inventory turns

- Profit improvement
- Production efficiency
- Expense avoidance
- · Customer retention
- Return on investment

Think about what areas in which you have achieved measurable results. For example:



Artifacts

Your portfolio's text copy impresses itself on your audience's left brain. Images, artwork, graphs, and the use of colors engage their right brain.

Decision-making is a whole brain activity. People respond not only to what you say, but how you say it. Given two candidates with comparable credentials, the candidate with the most compelling presentation has the greater chance of success.

Images that showcase your career successes cogently demonstrate the value you can bring to a hiring organization. Also, they tend to enhance the realism of your success in the minds of decision makers.

You can get all of these factors working for you with the intelligent use of imagery in your portfolio. To find images that add strength to your candidacy, think about the kinds of images companies put into their annual reports, such as photos of managers receiving awards, speaking to groups, and leading teams. Many professionals also create items that can be effectively displayed, such as business or consumer products or processes.

If you have any of these images, forward them to your career advisor for incorporation into your portfolio.

A career web portfolio can showcase your career in a way that is not constrained by a resume. It enhances and animates key information about you and your achievements.

You may include graphical artifacts (such as images and charts) in a career portfolio which add greater depth and dimensionality which strengthen your candidacy. Ask yourself if you have any of any of the following:

- Charts Organization charts, bar charts, graphs, etc.
- Presentations Copies of management presentations you have made highlighting measurable results of major projects or areas you were responsible for.
- **Spreadsheets** Copies of spreadsheets containing measurable results of major projects or areas you were responsible for.
- **Publications** Copies of articles written about the you or presentations you have made to professional associations.
- Awards & Recognition Awards, recognition, endorsement letters.
- Assessments Myers-Briggs; 360 Feedback, Mind maps, Skills maps.
- Community service Board memberships, community organizations.
- **Photos** Obtain a current photo for the your portfolio contact page. Ask yourself if you have photos of yourself receiving awards, presenting at conferences, product photo or group photos.
- **Endorsements** Letters of recommendation, performance appraisals.
- **LinkedIn** the working URL for your LinkedIn profile.


21st Century Technology


Your Portfolio In Job Search

You can hyperlink your web portfolio to your resume to attract attention from recruiters and get the initial calls.

Co-browse your career web portfolio with screening interviewers and hiring managers during telephone interviews. Take advantage of advertising psychology and the visual impact of the portfolio. This is an extraordinary way to create a tangible, positive impression.

When you arrive at your personal interview, the hiring manager will have already seen your web portfolio during your telephone interview. However, most professional and executive positions involve a series of interviews with several people. You may be speaking with the hiring manager's peers, staff, and boss.

In these meetings, you can use your portfolio to quickly display your most important achievements and demonstrate the value you can bring to the firm. This can further improve your competitive edge over other candidates and help you to receive the job offer.



Ten ways to maximize results with your portfolio

- 1. Promoting your website URL: Put your web site address in front of potential employers, interviewers and networking colleagues.
- 2. E-mailing your resume: Direct the recipient to your career web portfolio, e.g., "For your convenience, my resume is attached. You can also visit my career web portfolio to view additional information on my experience and skills."
- 3. Cover letters: When preparing cover letters to accompany resumes, add a closing section that mentions the career web portfolio, e.g., "My resume is enclosed; however, you can also view it online along with additional information on my experience, accomplishments and strengths at www.executivebio.net/williamsmith."
- 4. Business cards: Your business cards should carry your career web portfolio address along with traditional contact information.
- 5. E-mail signature line: Make your signature sell you whenever you send e-mail by adding your career web portfolio URL to your e-mail signature line.
- 6. Resume: Include your career web portfolio URL in the contact information on your resume, cover letter, interview follow up letters and any other documents.
- 7. Linked In: You can enrich the value of your Linked In profile by adding a link to your portfolio.
- 8. Telephone interview: Use your career web portfolio in the telephone interview. This is an extraordinary way to create a tangible, positive impression with your telephone interview. If the interviewer can visit your

career web portfolio during the interview, you have just increased your impact significantly. Even if the interviewer cannot visit the site while you are on the phone, you can give them the address before your phone interview ends.

- **9. Personal interview:** When the hiring manager invites you for a personal interview, ask them if they would mind sharing your web portfolio with the other executives you will be meeting with. Your portfolio then works for you to improve the quality of your interviews with the hiring manager's peers and staff (who will influence the hiring decision). These managers will be much more likely to read your portfolio than the stack of resumes on their desk.
- 10. Job offer: After you accept a job offer, you can use your portfolio during onboarding to help introduce yourself to your peers and co-workers in the new firm.
- 11. Business networking: Continual career networking activity after reemployment is considered essential by many experts. Your career web portfolio is a permanent career asset which can improve the effectiveness of your career networking activity in the years ahead. After you accept a job offer, inform your career advisor so they can have your portfolio updated to reflect your new position. 
